QPD is a mechanical test for assessing structural stability. QPD plus the addition of AI and Machine Learning are creating a future for dentistry of predictive diagnostics.

Dr. Cherilyn Sheets is the Founder and Co-Executive Director of the Newport Coast Oral Facial Institute, Founder of the Children's Dental Center in Inglewood, CA, Past-President of both the AAWD and the AAED, and also serves on numerous editorial boards.
